JOB DESCRIPTIONS

EXTERIOR SCENE SUPPORT FIREFIGHTER (BEFO)

- Performs fire scene operations outside of structures.
- Places water on fire from outside of house, connects hoses to hydrants, can perform rescue operations with additional training.
- Less dangerous than interior firefighting.

BEFO	79 hours

INTERIOR FIREFIGHTER (IFO)

- Performs all functions of a firefighter including fire extinguishment, and interior search, vehicle rescue and rope rescue.
- Some firefighters also perform roof operations such as ventilation.

EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN

- Provides direct medical care to patients.

FIRE POLICE

- Ensures a safe scene for firefighters and medical personnel by controlling traffic.
- Members typically respond directly to scene.

Fire Police Training Course	9 hours

APPARATUS OPERATOR: ENGINE/PUMPER/TANKER/LADDER

- Drives fire apparatus to emergency scene.
- Controls operations of the apparatus and equipment.
